ANOVAs (both one-way and two-way) are reported like the t test, but there are two degrees-of-freedom numbers to report. First report the between-groups degrees of freedom, then report the within-groups degrees of freedom (separated by a comma). After that report the F statistic (rounded off to two decimal places) and the significance level.

The general requirement for a statistical report is not as complicated as it may seem. You need to leave 1-inch margins on three sides of the page and a 1.5-inch margin on the left side in case the work is going to be put into a binder. There is no need to double-space your work, but keep the font neutral and readable.

The F statistics will always have two numbers reported for the degrees of freedom following the format: (df regression, df error). For statistics such as R^2 and p-values where the number before the decimal point is assumed to be zero, the 0 is omitted.

If you are reporting a list of statistics within parentheses, you do not need to use brackets within the parentheses. For example (SD = 1.5, CI = -5, 5) Use parentheses to enclose degrees of freedom. For example, $t(10) = 2.16$.
