The Midrash on Lamentations or Eichah (Lamentations) Rabbah (Hebrew: הכיא שרדמ), like Bereshit Rabbah and the Pesikta ascribed to Rab Kahana, belongs to the oldest works of the Midrashic literature. It begins with 36 consecutive poems forming a separate collection, certainly made by the author of the Midrash.
