Hearing voices or seeing visions is a relatively common human experience. Statistics vary, but anywhere between 3 and 10% of the general population hear voices at some point in their lives. Beavan et al (2010) put this figure as high as 13.7%. So, hearing voices - in itself - isn't a sign of mental ill health.
