Body lift perforator flap reconstruction uses a flap of tissue from both sides of the lower abdomen (DIEP) and the upper buttocks (SGAP, or hip flap) to reconstruct the breasts — two flaps per breast, or four flaps in all. DIEP stands for the deep inferior epigastric perforator artery, which runs through the abdomen.

Deep Inferior Epigastric Artery Perforator (DIEP) Flap. The DIEP flap is the technique where skin and tissue (no muscle) is taken from the abdomen in order to recreate the breast. The skin and subcutaneous fatty tissue of the lower abdomen provide tissue that has a soft texture and also provides adequate tissue for symmetric breast reconstruction.

Magnetic resonance angiography (MRA) is an extremely useful preoperative imaging test for evaluation of the vasculature of donor tissue to be used in autologous breast reconstruction. MRA has sufficient spacial resolution to reliably visualize 1-mm perforating vessels and to accurately locate vessels in reference to a patient's anatomic landmarks without exposing the patient to ionizing radiation or iodinated contrast.

A DIEP flap is considered a muscle-sparing type of flap. DIEP stands for the deep inferior epigastric perforator artery, which runs through the abdomen. In a DIEP flap, fat, skin, and blood vessels are cut from the wall of the lower belly and moved up to your chest to rebuild your breast. (In a properly performed DIEP, no muscle is cut or removed; if you're having DIEP flap, make sure this will be the case.)

Breast reconstruction with flap surgery is the most complex breast reconstructive option. Your surgeon transfers a section of skin, muscle, fat and blood vessels from one part of your body to your chest to create a new breast mound. In some cases, the skin and tissue need to be augmented with a breast implant to achieve the desired breast size.

Profunda artery perforator (PAP) flaps have risen as one of the second choice for autologous breast reconstruction due to sufficient amount of tissue available in thighs (172-695 g). 9-12 In our institution, we have performed 12 staged breast reconstructions (21 flaps) using thoracodorsal or serratus vessels in patients who had experienced a previous primary flap loss or dissatisfaction with prior breast reconstruction using internal mammary vessels.
